EHS Performing Arts & Competitive Gymnasium

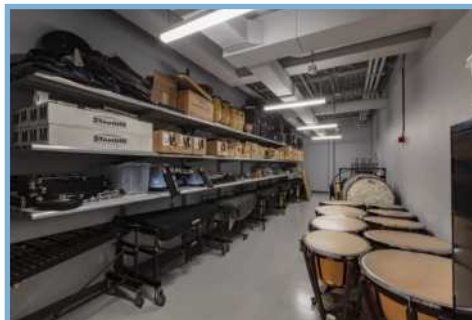
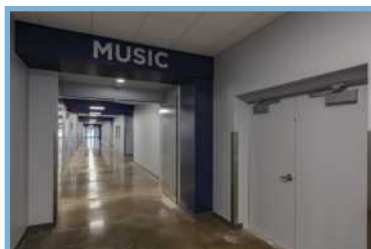


Enid Public Schools is proud of the competitive gymnasium and performing arts center. This first class facility provides space and accommodations for athletics, academic, music, drama, and media productions.

The new facility houses a fully equipped gymnasium with a competitive wrestling room as well as performing arts classrooms and a black box theatre. Additional classrooms are available, as well as a multimedia (media production) room. The media production room, next door to the Blackbox theater, is equipped with TV cameras, microphones, monitors and recording booths.

The fine arts portion includes band, choral, orchestra, media room, and Blackbox theater.

Performing arts classrooms and additional classrooms are available for activities, as well as a multimedia (media production) room. The media production room, next door to the Blackbox theater, is equipped with TV cameras, microphones, monitors and recording booths. The Blackbox has seating for up to 125, it has an extensive sound and light system as well as a projector for movies, slides, presentations.



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EHS Performing Arts & Competitive Gymnasium

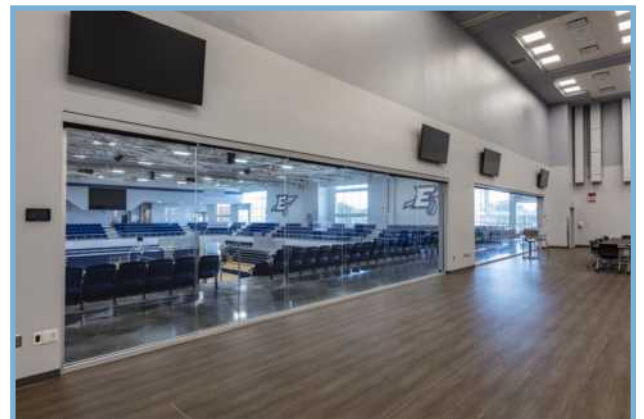
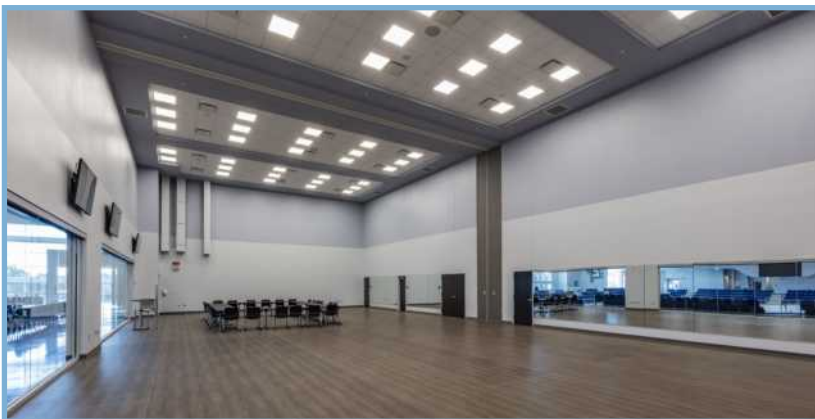
The gymnasium area specifically includes restrooms, a gym with a Grade 1 Maple Wood floor, bleachers, locker rooms, a wrestling room, security cameras and support spaces. Lighting is LED High Bay Fixtures, equipped for specific area control.



The 40,000 square foot gym is a combination of permanent and retractable bleachers will seat approximately 2,000 fans. Gym Locker Rooms 4 total, 2 equipped with smartboard technology, all have lockers, restrooms, showers, chairs. The wrestling room houses its own fully matted area and private locker room area. The Athletic Training Room includes ice machine, taping stations, heated pads.

The VIP/Spirit Room, also used for hospitality suite (refrigerator, microwave, sink, ice, coffee maker), has four tv monitors for movies, slides, or presentations. It has a divider so room can be split into two separate rooms.



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David Allen Memorial Ballpark



Enid Public Schools is home to one of the most unique high school baseball venues in the state. From the brick arches at the entrance of the stadium to the large video display board in the outfield, this is truly a magnificent facility. The stadium has a local baseball museum and an artificial turf practice infield and indoor batting cages.

The stands include 359 chair back seats that were imported from the old Baltimore Memorial Stadium as well as seating upstairs in the balcony area. Concessions and restrooms are available with a hospitality suite, grill, and several other accommodations.

Turf is Hellas Field Helix Turf Installed Fall to Spring 2019 2020.



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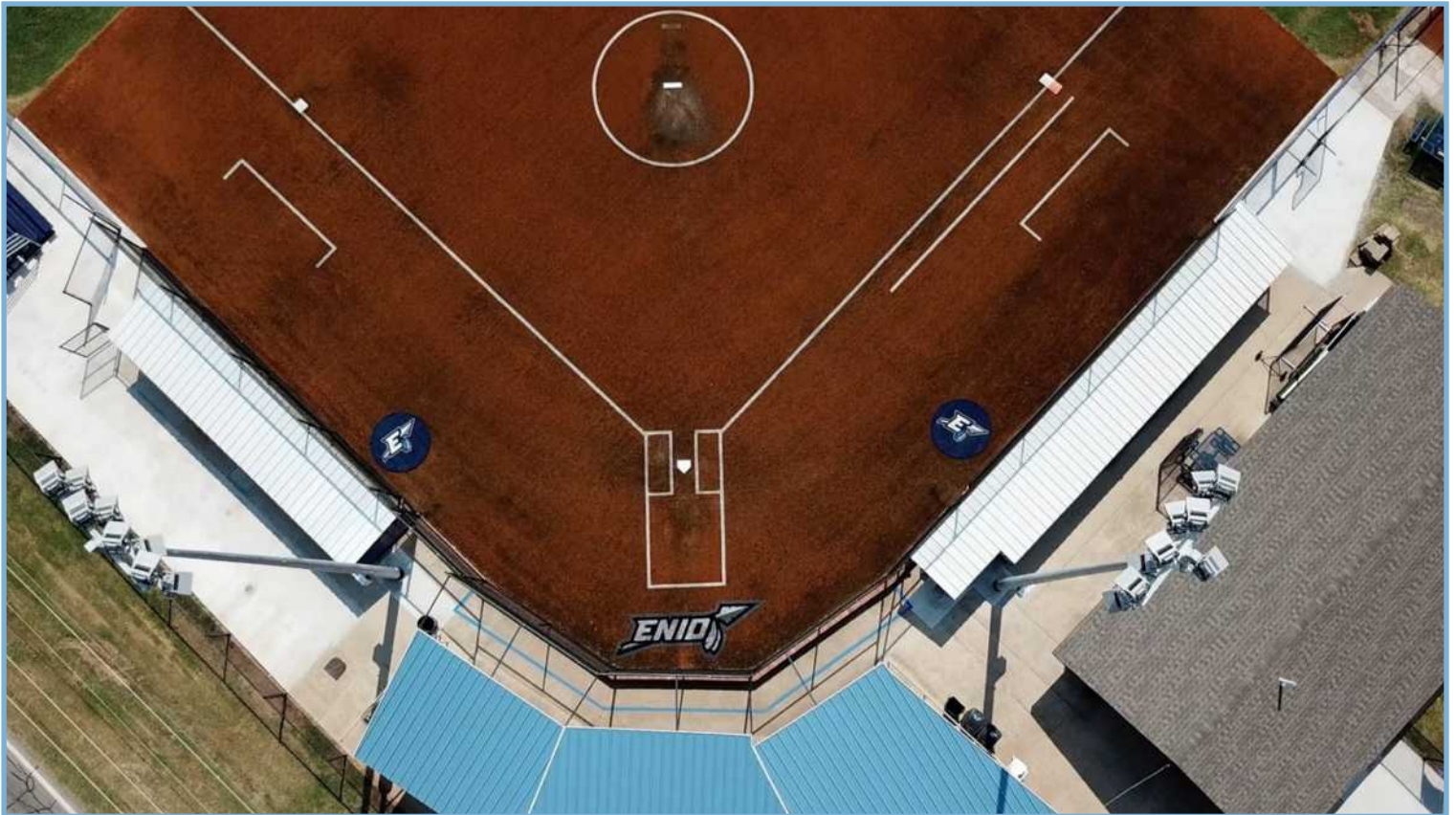


Meadowlake Park Pacer Field

This first class facility provides space and accommodations for softball with permanent seating for approximately 350 fans.

The facility houses a locker room, batting cages, and bull pens available on the home side.

Concessions and restrooms areas are available on Home.



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Enid High School Wrestling Room



The Wrestling Room has given Enid an exceptional area to work out. Located on the first level of the newly constructed Performing Arts and Athletic Center and next door to the gym, the home venue for meets. The practice area has two full sized mats that are utilized for team practices, camps and other assorted activities.



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Enid High School Strength Training Room

Just west of the new \$20 million basketball arena at Enid High School is a 4,800 square foot weight room, two racks of which are filled by multiple sets of dumbbells weighing up to 100 pounds in 5 pound increments. In the room are seven double sided, multipurpose racks that can accommodate both squats and band exercises simultaneously. The space, which opened last summer in time for the 2019 20 academic year, accommodates nearly 75 athletes at a time with training techniques both traditional (free weights and barbells) and trendy (plyo boxes and resistance bands), and fully branded to EHS.

State of the art sound system and strength and conditioning programs are used daily by the students and executed by the Strength and Conditioning Coach. Down the middle of this space there is a 25 yard by 4 yard strip of multipurpose turf to use for warm up, speed, explosion, and footwork drills.

For many sports programs, strength translates directly to success. Strength training is a major part of our physical development. Not only football, but all sports. Development of the total athlete is our major priority.



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D. Bruce Selby Stadium

Selby Stadium provides permanent seating space and accommodations for football and soccer with fan capacity of 5500 seats. The facility houses a fully equipped Athletic Training Facility as well as several modern locker room areas equipped with TV's and meeting room sections.

Concessions and restrooms areas are available on Home and Visitors side, and a Press Box hospitality area for 20 people with refrigerator.

All turf is Hellas Field Helix Turf Installed Fall to Spring 2019 2020, a natural grass field 100 x 70 yards is also available.

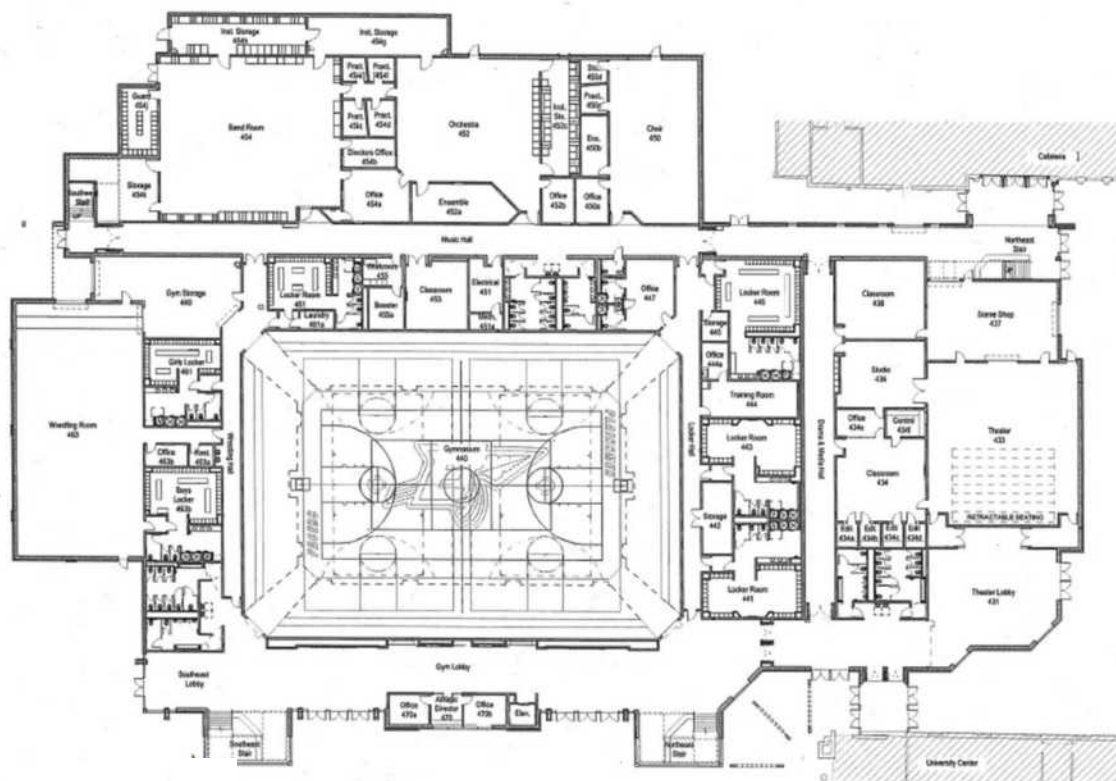

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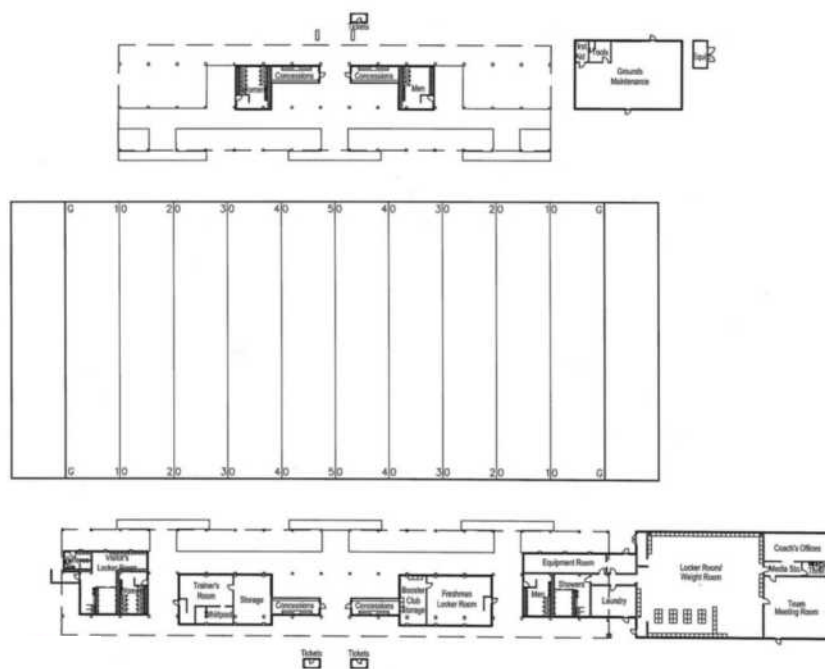
