GENERAL INFORMATION

A daytime softball camp for girls ages 6-12.

This Camp is of interest to any girl now playing softball or any girl who has never had the opportunity to learn how to play softball.

This camp is small enough for each and every player to receive personal attention.

CAMP PURPOSE: To help young girls get a good fundamental foundation for the game.

DAILY SCHEDULE: June 1 and 2

EQUIPMENT: Girls must furnish their own playing equipment including glove and bat (We will have a few team bats that may be used if you do not have one). Girls should wear long pants or softball pants because they will have sliding training and be expected to slide during practice games. Girls may wear cleats if they wish, but any type of shoe is acceptable.

EQUIPMENT FURNISHED: The Camp will furnish a Camp T-shirt, and we will have some catchers gear and helmets, but girls may bring their own. Girls should leave their own softballs at home.

SOMETHING FOR EVERY PLAYER

- I. For the girl that made the team, it teaches proper fundamentals and improves her play with added confidence.
- II. For the girl who made the team but is sitting on the bench, it helps her keep up with the team and in some cases, find a starting spot.
- III. The Camp is not competitive. Each girl gets the attention she needs and all girls get to play regardless of ability. The Camp helps a girl enjoy and appreciate the game of softball.
